

Athletic Code/Eligibility

(To be read and signed by athlete and parent)

Queens Grant High School is a proud member of the PAC 8. (Piedmont Athletic Conference). This conference includes: Grace Academy, Pine Lake Prep, Comenius School, Lincoln Charter, Lake Norman Charter, Countryside Montessori, and Covenant Classical.

-As stated in our PAC by-laws: "Any student who has not reached his or her **19th** birthday on or before **October 16** of the participation year, who in a bona fide undergraduate student of a league member school, and who is considered qualified, academically and otherwise, by any member of the school may participate in league athletic contests."

-As stated in our PAC by-laws: "No student in grade 11 or 12 may participate in JV games". JV players may play up, but not if they fall short of a 24 hour time period. "During tournament competition a player can only participate at one level throughout the length of the tournament."

-As stated in our PAC by-laws: "Students who are currently a member of a team, and who transfer from a school within or from outside the conference during a sport season must sit out the remainder of that season." (Mid year transfers, lose the right to participate in whatever season is already in play. This includes conference and non conference games).

-A current physical (within one year) must be turned in to the athletic director before ANY participation in sports. (**This includes tryouts**).

-All forms must be signed and fees turned in to the athletic director *after* the team is formed and *before* the first official practice.

Grade Eligibility:

-The athletic director will check athlete's grades every two weeks. On the first check, if a student athlete becomes ineligible, he/she will be given a written academic warning until the next grade check. This gives the student athlete a notice, and some time to bring his/her grade up to acceptable range.

-If the grade is not in acceptable range at the second check then the student athlete will be placed on suspension. Suspension will be lifted as soon as the grade(s) are in acceptable range.

-Academic suspension includes games/events. The athlete is still expected to attend practice.

-1F or 2D's will place a student athlete on suspension.

-If a student athlete is suspended from school (OSS), he/she will be suspended from all participation in sports until the last day of suspension

is served. (This includes games and practices).

-If at ANY time a student athlete is found using, holding, purchasing, or selling tobacco, alcohol, illegal substances or weapons on school campus, the situation will immediately go to the principal and consequences will be based on our school policy.

-Removal of athlete from a team by the coach will not be official until approved by the athletic director and principal. Parents/athlete will be notified once final decision is made.

-A student athlete must be in school at least ½ of the day to participate in practice or games. (Unless approved by the A.D. or Principal)

-GAME DAY UNIFORM:

LADIES: Plain black dress pants and a plain white button up dress top. No excessive jewelry/makeup.

GENTLEMEN: Plain khaki/black dress pants (NO CARGOS), a plain white button up dress shirt, and a tie.

-Athletic Director and/or Principal/Vice Principal have the right to alter anything on this eligibility, due to specific/special circumstances.
